
Parts of a Comic Book Page


- Panel One illustration in a square or rectangular frame. Sometimes in a circular or irregularlyshaped panel.
- Gutter The space on a comic book page that is outside the panels.



- Speech Balloons Contain what a character is saying. Usually round.
- Thought Balloons Contain what a character is thinking. Usually has lumpy edges, like clouds.
- Pointers Indicate which character is speaking.
- Bubbles Indicate which character is thinking.



- *Title* Name of the comic or story.
- Credits Names of the writers and artists of the comic.





 Captions – Words that are not in speech or thought balloons.
Usually in a square or rectangle.

 Sound Effects - Words that depict noises or sounds.
