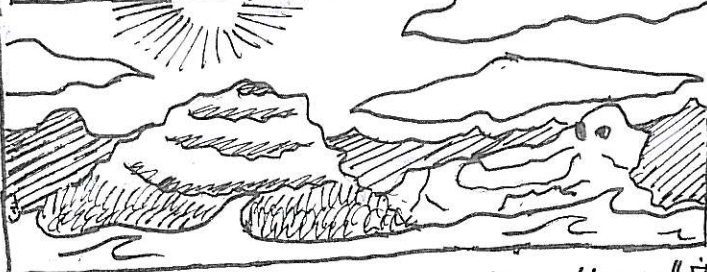


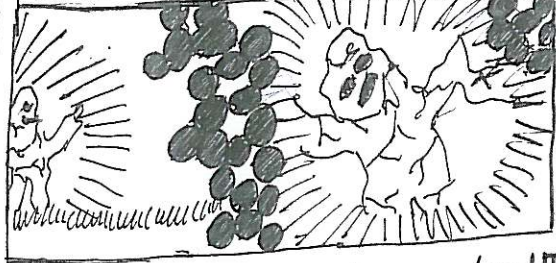
LEGEND OF SAGRES' MAN

There is a legend about a celtic man (come to Aguiro). In this place "Oertrimnos" (first Galician People) lived.



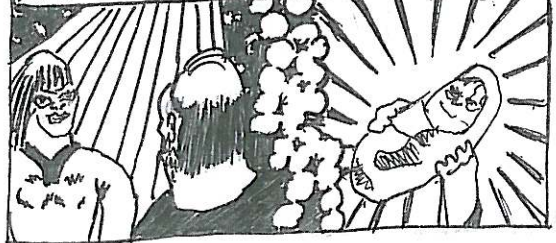
This village had a spell: "If somebody wanted to conquer it, they turned into stone."



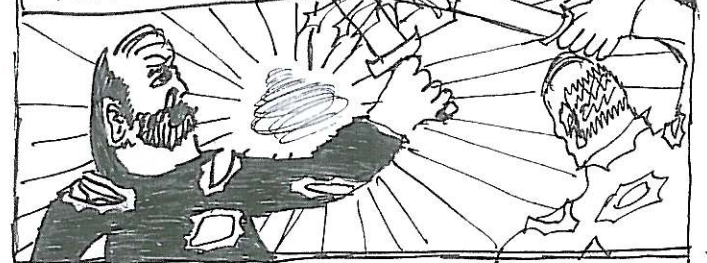

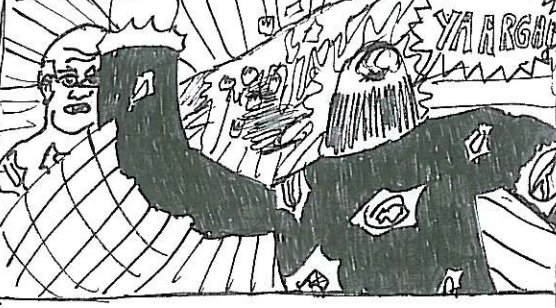
Forcadina and Sagres get married, and had one son, Noro.



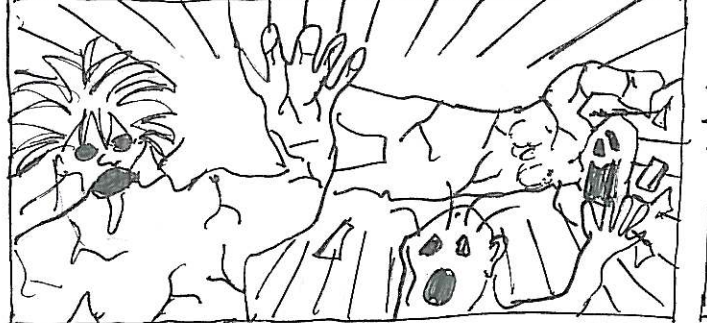
But everything found out, and Sagres and Falcoeiro fought hardly.



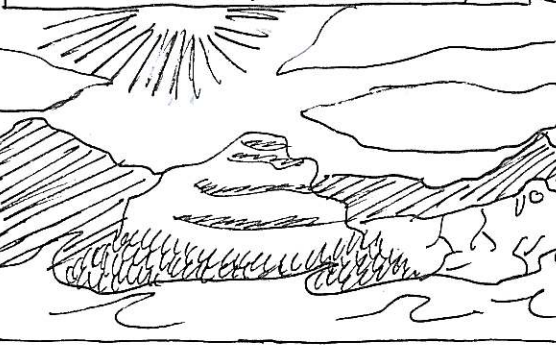
Sagres' tongue was cut in seven pieces, his jaw and his back teeth too.
