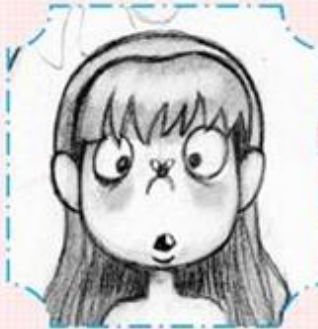


Emily's portrait
