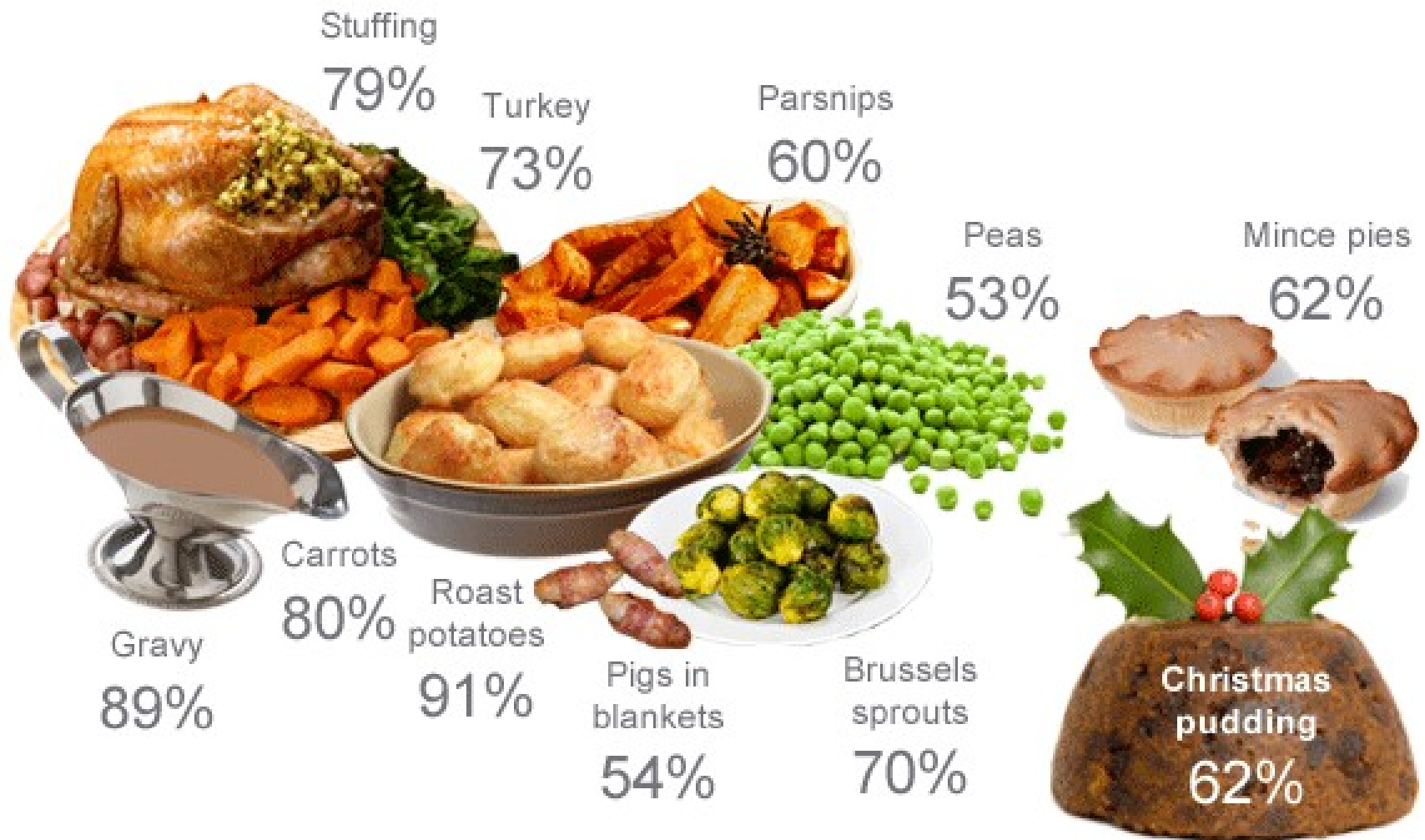
# Christmas Dinner

# Christmas traditions

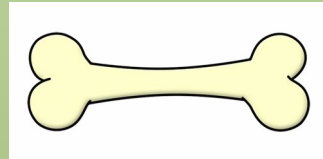
- Christmas crackers – in every cracker there is a small toy, a paper crown and a joke.

• A mushroom.



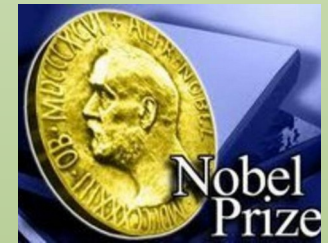
• **What kind of paper likes music?**
