

- What was smallpox?
- What did Edward Jenner discover?

In the 18th century, a terrible disease called smallpox killed 10% of the population every year. It killed men, women and children. It killed rich people and poor people. It killed kings and queens.

In 1796, Edward Jenner was a doctor. He worked in a small village in England.







Don't worry, Sarah. You

You've got cowpox. It

Jenner noticed that people who got cowpox didn't get smallpox.

Jenner asked a boy from the village to do an experiment with him. He rubbed pus from one of Sarah's spots into a scratch on the boy's arm.
