PRESENT SIMPLE REVISION

Do you remember? We use the Present Simple to talk about habits and routines.

We also use it with **frequency adverbs** (always, usually, often, sometimes, never---
adverbs go **before** the verb).

Examples:

I sleep in my bed every night. --- She sleep**S** in her bed every night.

I never have dinner in the morning.--- He never **has** dinner in the morning.

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I go	I don't go	Do I go ?
You go	You don't go	Do you go ?
He goes	He doesn't go	Does he go ?
She goes	She doesn't go	Does she go ?
It goes	It doesn't go	Does it go ?
We go	We don't go	Do we go ?
You go	You don't go	Do you go ?
They go	They don't go	Do they go ?
