Do you remember? We use the Present Simple to talk about habits and routines.

We also use it with <u>frequency adverbs</u> (always, usually, often, sometimes, never---adverbs go <u>before</u> the verb).

Examples:

I sleep in my bed every night. --- She sleep5 in her bed every night.

I never have dinner in the morning.--- He never has dinner in the morning.


