### AFFIRMATIVE

I **am**  
You **are**  
He/She/It **is**  
We/You/They **are**

### NEGATIVE

I **am not**  
You **aren't**  
He/She/It **isn't**  
We/You/They **aren't**

### INTERROGATIVE

**Am** I?  
**Are** you?  
**Is** he/she/it?  
**Are** we/you/they?

# Don't - Doesn't

We use **Don't** or **Doesn't** to make a **negative sentence** in the simple present tense.\*

\* Exceptions: Negative sentences that use *To Be* or *Modal Verbs* (can, might, etc.)

Subject	Auxiliary	Verb **
I / you / we / they	<b>don't</b>	go ... want ... like ...
he / she / it	<b>doesn't</b>	

Affirmative: You speak English.

Negative: You **don't** speak English.

Affirmative: He speaks English.

Negative: He **doesn't** speak English.

\*\* The base form of the infinitive = ~~to~~ go, ~~to~~ need, ~~to~~ speak, ~~to~~ live  
Third person verbs lose the final "s" in negative sentences.

Be careful... I ~~no~~ live in Japan. ❌

I **don't** live in Japan. ✅

Affirmative: She has a cat. ✅

Negative: She **doesn't** ~~has~~ a cat. ❌

Negative: She **doesn't** have a cat. ✅

= do not

doesn't

= does not
