NARRATOR 3: They ask for some food.

TRAMP 1: We're very hungry. Please, can you give us some bread?

PERSON 1: Sorry, I'm very poor, I haven't got any bread.

TRAMP 2: We're very hungry. Please, can you give us some food?

PERSON 2: I'm very sorry, I haven't got any food.

NARRATOR 1: The children knock at some more doors.

TRAMP 1: What can we do?

TRAMP 2: We're very hungry.

NARRATOR 2: Then, they have an idea.

TRAMP 1: Stone soup! Stone soup is delicious!, but... we need a big pot, some water and some wood!

PERSON 3: I've got a pot at home. Wait a minute, I can get it.

PERSON 4: I can give you some water.

PERSON 5: I've got some wood too.

PERSON 6: Stone soup? Is it nice?

TRAMP 2: Yes, it's delicious.

NARRATOR 3: The tramps start the fire.

NARRATOR 1: They put the pot on the fire.

NARRATOR 2: The tramps taste the soup.

TRAMP 1: Mmmm...! It's very good! What do you think?

TRAMP 2: I like it but... it needs some salt, some pepper and some oil.

PERSON 7 : I've got some salt and some pepper.

PERSON 8: Here you are, some olive oil.

NARRATOR 3: The old tramp puts some salt, pepper and oil into the pot.

PERSON 1: I've got some carrots!

NARRATOR 1: The tramps put the vegetables into the pot.

TRAMP 2: Mmmmm...! It's very, very good! But it needs some meat.

PERSON 6: I've got some sausages!

PERSON 8: I've got some beef!

PERSON 9: And some chicken!

NARRATOR 2: They put the meat into the pot.

TRAMP 1: Mmmm...! Stone soup is delicious!

TRAMP 2: We can eat it now.

NARRATOR 3: There is soup for everybody.

NARRATOR 1: And later...

TRAMP 1: We must go now.

PERSON 1: Please, don't leave. Stay with us. You can make stone soup with your magic stone.
