Visit to the island of San Simón, beautiful site of the Vigo bay full of history and literature.




15:45 Back to Cobres dock in kayak. Hot chocolate and transfer by bus to Vigo to visit the city with the largest population in Galicia

Saturday 21th



Tuesday 24th


09:15 We will depart by bus to visit Santiago de Compostela.

11:00 Visit the roofs of the Cathedral. 12:00 Pilgrim's Mass. Botafumeiro.




Tuesday 24th 014:00 Stop at Bonaval park for lunch and continue with the cultural route.
