<b>Highcliffe Castle</b>	Highcliffe Castle is not only a beautiful and historical building, but the surrounding grounds are perfect for a relaxing stroll on the lawns. There is direct access to both a wonderful sandy beach and the unspoilt nature reserve of nearby Steamer Point. Romantic and Picturesque' both descriptively and architecturally, the L-shaped Highcliffe Castle was built in 1835 by Lord Stuart de Rothesay to incorporate carved medieval stonework and stained glass from France and beyond. A superb example of Gothic Revival style.
