HOW DO YOU SEE YOUR PROFESSIONAL FUTURE AFTER BACCALAURÉAT?

The current situation is very bad. We are immerse in an economic crisis and there aren't any jobs either for people with an academic formation or for people with no studies.

A lot of students would like to go to university. This is indeed my case, but I don't know if I must think about a possible professional future for me once I finish my university studies or I must simply study what I want to.

After Baccalauréat, if we do not go on studying, we haven't got any job prospects. We can either do Higher Vocational Training or go to University, but we have to do something. We have to overcome the crisis to be able to get a job, especially people who have not completed their upper secondary studies.

To conclude, nowadays we are asked to have both experience and academic studies in order to be able to have a job, but we cannot get experience before having a job opportunity, and so we, young people, are facing a very serious problem. As an example, if I wanted to work in a bakery, I could not because experience would be required and I wouldn't have experience because nobody would give me the opportunity.
