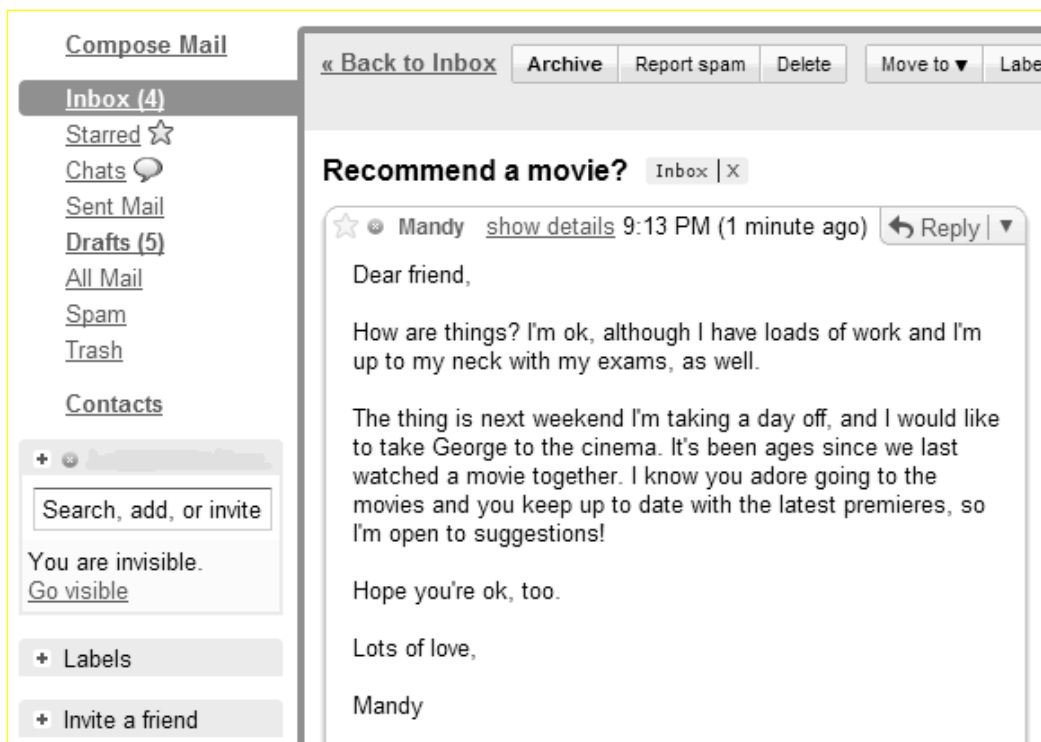
TASK 1

 - Do not forget to include: sender, addressee, subject and opening and closing remarks.


TASK 2
