HISTORY

1. Augustus Caesar **WAS** the first Roman Emperor (TRUE - He founded the Roman Empire and ruled from 27 BC - 14 AD)
2. The French Revolution **DIDN'T BEGIN** in 1879 (FALSE - 1789)
3. The Vikings **CAME** from Scandinavia (TRUE)
4. The Incas **DIDN'T LIVE** in Mexico (FALSE - They lived in Peru. The Aztecs lived in Mexico.)
5. The Egyptians **BUILT** the Pyramids of Giza (TRUE - The pyramids of Cheops (Khufu), Chephren (Khafre), Mycerinus (Menkaura)

THE ARTS

6. Vincent Van Vogh **PAINTED** the "Sunflowers" (TRUE, in 1888)
7. The Beatles **DIDN'T SING** the song "Imagine" (FALSE- It was written and performed by John Lennon in 1971 - the Beatles had broken up officially in 1970)
8. Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart **WASN'T** a Swiss composer (FALSE . He was Austrian, born in Salzburg in 1756)
9. The Italian artist Leonardo da Vinci **PRODUCED** his masterpieces during the Renaissance period. (TRUE - The Italian Renaissance generally goes from the middle of the 14th to the end of the 16th century. Some of Leonardo's masterpieces are: The Last Supper 1494-1498; Mona Lisa 1503-1519
10. Jane Austen **PUBLISHED** the novel "Pride and Prejudice" in 1813 (TRUE).

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

11. Neil Armstrong **LANDED** on the moon in 1969. (TRUE)
12. Charles Darwin **WROTE** "On the Origin of Species". (TRUE, in 1859)
13. Bill Gates **DIDN'T INVENT** the telephone. (FALSE, Alexander Graham Bell patented it in 1876, while Antonio Meucci had created but never patented a prototype in 1874)
14. Albert Einstein **ELABORATED** the famous equation $E = mc^2$ (TRUE- it appeared in the form of $m = E/c^2$ in the last page of his "Special relativity" published in 1905 - The energy of a particle = its mass times the square of the speed of light)
15. Alfred Nobel, who inspired the Nobel Prize, **DIDN'T DEVELOP** the "Big Bang" theory (FALSE- He invented dynamite and other explosives at the end of the 19th century)

SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT

16. The 2000 Olympic Games **DIDN'T TAKE PLACE** in Greece. (FALSE - They took place in Sydney, Australia. The 2004 Olympic Games took place in Athens, Greece)
17. The actress Elizabeth Taylor **GOT MARRIED** eight times. (TRUE)
18. Joe di Maggio _____ **PLAYED** baseball in the New York Yankees. (TRUE)
19. Zac Efron **DIDN'T STAR** in the movie "Twilight". (FALSE- Robert Pattinson/Taylor Lautner starred in the movie "Twilight". Zac Efron starred in movies like "High School Musical", "Hairspray", "17 again".
20. George Disney **DIDN'T CREATE** Mickey Mouse (FALSE - Walt Disney created Mickey Mouse in 1928)
