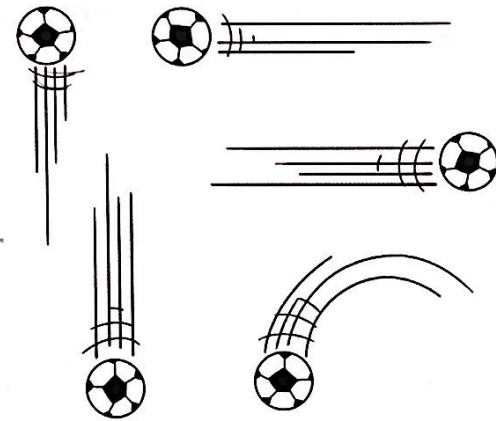
1 Where can you see movement in this illustration?

Illustrators draw pictures to tell stories. These pictures are called **illustrations**.

Illustrators draw pictures of the **characters** in a story.

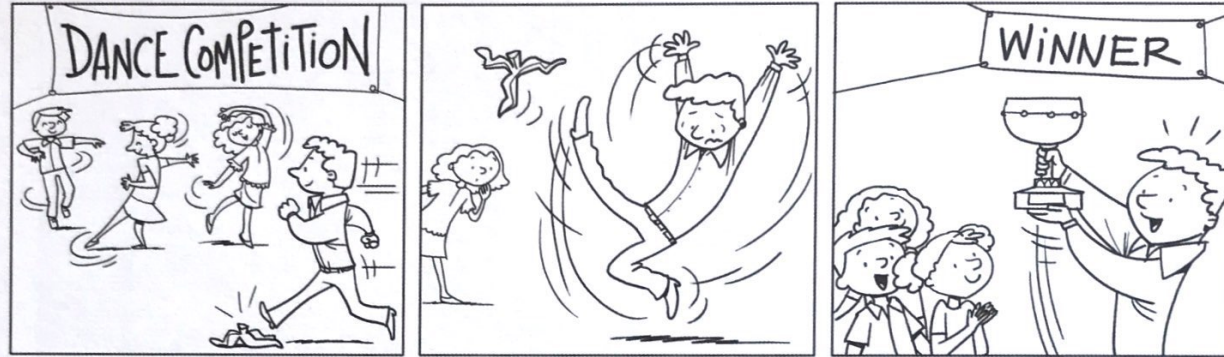
The lines in illustrations show **movement**.



Movement goes forwards and backwards, side to side, up and down, and around and around.

Read the sentence and draw your character.



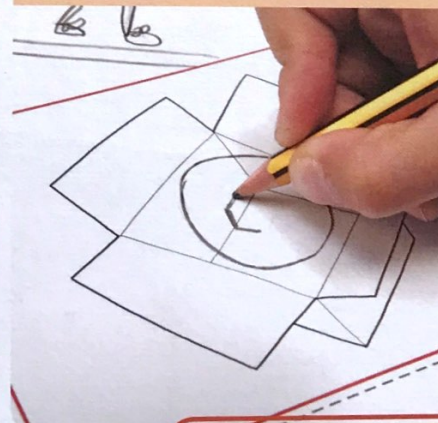
Step 2

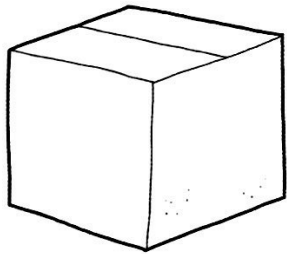
