


American Inventions

- Inventions helped increase speed and encouraged mass production
- Cotton gin (1792): the industrial revolution was taking off in the Northeast- on the other hand, the invention of the cotton gin only further encouraged the use of slave labor in the South.
 - This invention separated the seeds from the cotton
 - Could do 50 times the work that a person could do in a day
 - Provided the raw material for the booming textile industry



- United States Railroad System: this system now connects the east and west
- Telephone: Invented by Alexander Graham Bell, this invention encouraged more efficient communication
- The automobile and assembly line: Henry Ford

United States Railroad System: this system now connects the east and west



Henry Ford & the Assembly Line

- Invented the first automobile under the Ford Motor Company
- High demand led to a new system of production, called the "assembly line."
