**NARRATOR 1:** Sami had another idea!

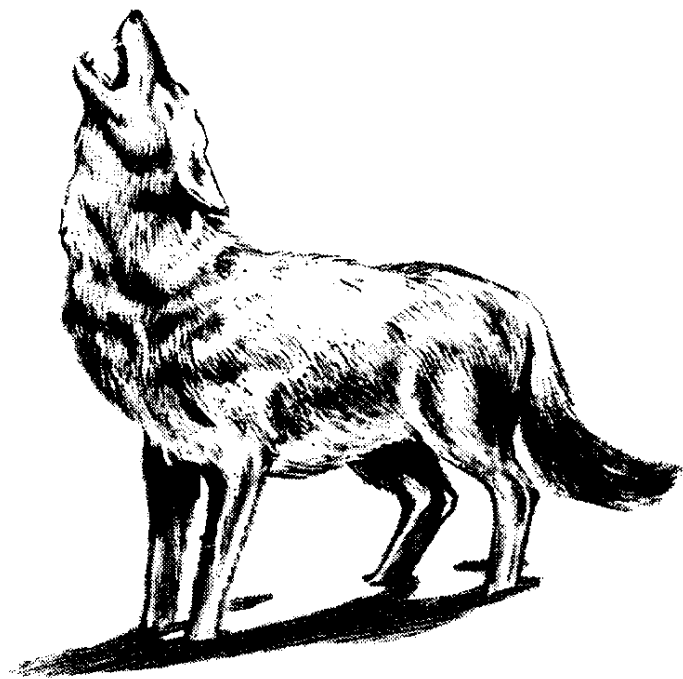
**SAMI:** I know, I'll play another trick.
