

# INFINITIVE

## Infinitive +to

- Despois de adxectivos: I am **happy** to see you are well
- Despois de substantivos: I've got **homework** to do
- Despois de verbos: I **want** to pass this subject
- Verbos con complementos: I **want you** to pass **English**
- Despois de partículas interrogativas: He knows **what** to do

## Infinitive -to

- Despois de verbos modais: I **can** go now
- Despois de make / let / see / hear con complemento directo: **Let it** be
- Despois de had better e would rather: **You'd better** study

# Forma +ing

## 1. Substantivo verbal:

- ✓ **Suxeito:** **Dancing** is easy and funny
- ✓ **Complemento:** I find reading easy without noise
- ✓ **Despois de preposición:** I will go out after studying

## 2. Despois de verbos como suggest, finish, etc:

I suggest going to the disco.

# To or ing?

Agree, arrange, attempt, be, can afford, choose, dare, decide, expect, fail, forget, have, hope, learn, manage, need, offer, ought

**I agree to explain it again**

Avoid, can't help, dislike, enjoy, finish, go on, imagine, keep, mind, miss, practise, risk, stop, suggest, it's no fun, it's no good, it's no use, it's worth

**Please, avoid doing it again**

Begin, start, continue, intend, propose, forbid

**Mary began to write**

Begin, start, continue, intend, propose, forbid

**Mary began writing**

Would like/love/ hate/prefer

**I would like to be there now**

Like/love/hate/prefer

**I like drawing and painting**

Remember, not forget

**He remembered to bring the book**

Remember, not forget

**I remember feeling well there**

Try

**Try to learn some new words**

Try

**If it doesn't work, try adding some salt**

Stop

**He was talking and stopped to drink**

Stop

**Stop doing that, please**
