WISH CLAUSES

WEUSE

"TWISH"

TOEXPRESS

REGRET

OR

DISSATISFACTION

FOR THE PRESENT AND FUTURE

WE USE "I WISH" + PAST SIMPLE OR PAST CONTINUOUS

I wish I <u>had</u> more money

I wish I weren't working at this moment

FOR THE FUTURE showing that it is not likely to happen

WE USE
"I WISH" + CONDITIONAL

I wish I would go to England next summer

FOR THE PAST

WE USE "I WISH" + PAST PERFECT

I wish I <u>had studied</u> more for the exam

I wish I <u>hadn't lied</u> to my friend

IF THE WISH IS A GOOD ONE I HOPE + PRESENT SIMPLE OR WILL

I hope you <u>feel</u> well I hope the war <u>will stop</u> soon

IF THE WISH IS ABOUT DOING SOMETHING DIFFICULT OR IMPOSSIBLE

I WISH I COULD...

I wish you <u>could hear</u> it I wish I <u>could pass</u> this subject

WE CAN REPLACE I WISH WITH IF ONLY FOR EMPHASIS

If only I hadn't watched that film
If only I could speak English well
