25. Read the tourism article about the Bulgarian Rose Festival. Answer the questions.

Every year in the town of Kazanlak in central Bulgaria, there is a rose festival. Thousands of tourists come from all over the world for the festival. It normally takes place at the beginning of June, the start of the rose harvest. This is the time when people pick the roses.

Kazanlak, in the Valley of the Roses, is the centre of the rose industry. Bulgaria is also one of the biggest producers of rose oil in the world. It is called the ‘liquid gold’ of Bulgaria and is three times more expensive than real gold! It is used in the production of perfumes, chocolates, liqueurs and jams. You need 3000 kilograms of rose petals to make one kilogram of rose oil and pickers must pick every flower by hand! The harvest lasts between 20 and 25 days. During this time the pickers get up before sunrise to pick the roses before they have fully opened.

The first rose festival took place in 1903 and now people in national costume parade through the streets. At the end of the festival people choose a young woman to be ‘Queen of the Roses’. Rose flowers are everywhere and their smell fills the air. It really is a magical event and it celebrates the beauty of nature and one of Bulgaria’s most important products.

The festival is perfect for anyone interested in local customs and traditions. You’ll find that Kazanlak offers all visitors a very warm welcome and plenty of Bulgarian hospitality, so come on, what are you waiting for?
