Learning how to do an oral task

1. Needs: a bank of material.

What is your preferred comic book, novel, film, record, song, videogame?

How would you like to share it with other people?

2. Task:

Prepare a 'physical' image of it (a poster, A4, a powerpoint presentation, any kind of way you think can be 'image'. You can only use photos, drawings or images to reflect the general presentation.

It should include:

- A short description of the theme, topic, story...
- A short explanation why you like it.
- Only the name of the novel, film, etc., can be written text.

Prepare a short oral exposition (5-7min) to present your project. You have to talk about:

Presenting the novel, record, etc.,

Why we have chosen it.

What we have done.

What it is about.

Why I think you should like it too.

How to do it.

In groups of two.

Agree on the topic.

Agree on the presentation.

Look for the images.

Prepare the product.

Present it to the rest of us.

A balanced exposition is required!!!
